

Somervell County Hospital District Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The Somervell County Hospital District will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 5.4 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax calculated under Tax Code, Chapter 26).

Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on **September 14, 2015 at 7:00 P.M.** in the **Glen Rose Medical Center 2nd Floor Board Room located at 1021 Holden Glen Rose, Texas**

The second public hearing will be held on **September 17, 2015 at 7:00 P.M.** in the **Somervell County Citizens Center located at 209 S.W. Barnard St. Glen Rose, Texas**
